HORSMONDEN NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN (HNDP)

The Horsmonden Neighbourhood Development Plan was 'made' by Tunbridge Wells Borough Council at Full Council on 5 July 2023. This means that the HNDP now carries full weight in the determination of planning applications within the Horsmonden Parish.

HORSMONDEN WILDFLOWER PLANTING PROJECT

You may have seen the signs around the grass and tree area at Fromandez Drive and wondered what was going on.

The Parish Council are actively involved in making this area Bee Friendly and more attractive to other pollinators. There are now three fenced areas in which Yellow Rattle and other wildflower seedlings are being nurtured. The grass area will be mowed off at the end of August and in the autumn wildflower bulbs will be planted.

ROAD WORKS

HIGHWAYS IMPROVEMENT PLAN (HIP)

The Parish Council has a Highways Improvement Plan (HIP) which they are pursuing with Kent Highways regarding areas of highway in the parish they would like to see improved or made safer. This is effectively a 'wish list' and each item has to be considered individually by Kent Highways.

We have recently been successful in securing funding for bend warning signage and SLOW road markings on the carriageway near to properties in Yew Tree Green Road. We hope that residents will agree that this is a worthwhile safety measure.

SPEEDWATCH - CAN YOU HELP?

Speedwatch is a community-based scheme where volunteers record the speed of passing vehicles in the area where they live. Around 90% of vehicles observed once by Speedwatch volunteers are not seen speeding again in the next 12 months.

We already have an active Speedwatch group in Horsmonden, who do a great job, but they are always in need of more volunteers.

ROAD SAFETY PRESENTATION FOR MATURE DRIVERS AND PASSENGERS.

The Morning WI Group and Parish Council have worked together to arrange a free presentation on road safety for mature drivers on Tuesday 19th September at 2.30pm in Horsmonden Village Hall.

The presentation encompasses general road safety for all drivers, passengers and road users and is predominantly aimed at drivers over 60 years old, however please feel free to come along if you are under 60 and feel an informal refresher would help! Topics covered will be common crash causation, impairment, including driver fatigue, driving whilst taking prescribed medication, smart motorways and eco driving tips.

The session will run for approximately one and a half hours – so will end around 4pm.
