## PARISH COUNCIL AUDIT AND ACCOUNTS

The Parish Council has now completed its Annual Governance and Accountability Return together with internal auditing for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 and has sent all the relevant information off to the external auditors, Mazaars LLP who are responsible for completing the external audit.

Details of the accounts will be posted on the Parish Council's website under 'Finances and Audit' and will be available for public viewing by appointment from 6<sup>th</sup> June to 17<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

## SUPPORTING THE KENT PLAN BEE PROJECT

The Parish Council are pleased to announce their support and participation in Kent's Plan Bee project and their "No Mow May" initiative by allowing the grass area at Fromandez Drive to grow during the spring and summer months providing opportunities for feeding and nesting pollinators.

The Council's maintenance contractor will continue to regularly strim around the edges of the green area to allow sight lines to be maintained and around the young memorial trees so that they do not become overgrown. At the end of the season the long grass will be cut and removed to allow the meadow to grow again the following year.

The Parish Council plans to monitor the area's progress and over seed with wild flowers and native bulbs over the next few years to try and create a wild flower meadow which can encourage pollinating insects.
