HOW TO MAKE A HOUSING APPLICATION IN HORSMONDEN

Those wishing to apply for an allocation of social housing will need to qualify to join the Borough Council's Housing Register.

You can apply by creating an application on the Kent Homechoice website

(https://www.kenthomechoice.org.uk/) where you will need to upload documents to support your application. Once your application has been accepted as qualifying to join the Housing Register, you will be placed into one of four priority Bands, dependent on your circumstances and housing need.
