#### **HORSMONDEN HORSE FAIR 2023**

The September horse fair seemed to run smoothly this year with a slightly larger turn out than the last few years. There was a bit of tidying up to be done after the event but the organisers had this under control and were happy to all muck in to ensure that the village green was left just as they found it.

#### **ROAD WORKS**

There have been quite a number of road closures recently. It is great that works are being carried out but we get very little notice to allow us to advertise them. Keep an eye on our website and Facebook pages and we will share the information as quickly as we can.

### **HIGHWAYS IMPROVEMENT PLAN (HIP)**

The Parish Council has a Highways Improvement Plan (HIP) which they are pursuing with Kent Highways regarding areas of highway in the parish they would like to see improved or made safer. This is effectively a 'wish list' and each item has to be considered individually by Kent Highways.

We have recently been successful in securing funding for some pedestrian in road warning signs with 'no footway' plates and complementing SLOW markings on Maidstone Road from the end of the 30mph zone up to Swigs Hall. We hope that residents will agree that this is a worthwhile safety measure.
