Proposal:	Variation of Condition 8 (Vehicle Charging Points) of Planning Permission 18/01976/FULL - Rewording to be amended as follows "Prior to the erection of the buildings hereby approved, written and illustrative details of the number, type and location of charge points shall be provided in accordance with the authorities guidance not on 'Provision of Electric Vehicle Charging Points for New Development'."

Comments	Propose acceptance on the grounds that it is a reasonable development to the property but it should be in line with the Horsmonden Parish Council Sustainability Policy.

Location:	Quince Cottage, School House Lane, Horsmonden, Tonbridge, Kent, TN12 8BJ
Recommendation	Refusal
Proposal	Cllr Larkin; seconded Cllr Jenkinson. Carried by those present
Comments	Propose refusal as an over-development of the site and there is no evidence of adequate parking provision for all the occupants of the property.

5. PROVISION OF PLAY FACILITIES AT GIBBETT LANE/FURNACE LANE DEVELOPMENT (18/01976/FULL & 21/01167/FULL)

The Clerk had received an email from a representative of the developer regarding the play facilities in the proposed development.

After consideration by the Council, the Clerk will advise the developer that the Council is happy for the play area to be developed as a children's "natural style" play area as outlined and as shown on the original site plans.

The Council wanted to draw particular attention to the health and safety aspects of the attenuation pond and its close vicinity to the proposed play area. The Council did also suggest that the developer may wish to contact the local primary school and/or kindergarten to ask for their opinion on what sort of play equipment they would like to see in the area.'
