- Notes:
- 1) Annual Meeting of the Council. This can be held any day in May (except in an election year when it is held between the day the new councillors take office or within 14 days thereafter). The special significance of this meeting is that it elects the Chair and committee make-up for the following year and agrees annual contracts which require renewal. Other than this, the council may then continue to discuss those matters normally raised at a parish council meeting
  - 2) Annual Parish Meeting is held on any day between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 1<sup>st</sup> June (inclusive). This is not the same event as the Annual Meeting of the Council and although presided over by the Chair of the council, any matter affecting the parish specifically can be raised by an elector of the parish. Horsmonden Parish Council usually presents its accounts for the previous end of financial year for electors to examine at this meeting.
  - 3) Planning Committee meetings will be subject to change according to the number of applications received.
  - 4) The scheduled Finance committee meeting will be used by the Finance Committee to examine each budgeted item on the precept and recommend a precept for the following year. The Council's annual Risk Assessment will also be examined at this meeting. Other Finance meetings will take place throughout the year to monitor budgetary control and details of these will be publicised by additional agendas on the Notice boards and websites at least 3 clear working days in advance.  
Financial matters of a day to day nature will be discussed at monthly Parish Council meetings and the Parish Council's accounts assessed and checked for accuracy at each meeting.
