IMPROVED SECURITY MEASURES

AT THE PUBLIC TOILETS

The Parish Council are pleased to announce the installation of a new security gate at the public toilets, designed to restrict access around the back of the building and improve safety for all users. In addition, a CCTV system has now been fitted to help deter vandalism and anti-social behaviour.

These improvements are part of the Council's ongoing commitment to keeping the facilities open, clean, and problem-free for residents and visitors alike. Over the past few years, the Parish Council has invested a significant amount of money in repairs, cleaning, and maintenance due to repeated vandalism and misuse. This latest investment aims to protect that expenditure and ensure the toilets remain a valued community asset.

The Parish Council would like to thank everyone for their understanding and continued support as we work to maintain safe and welcoming public facilities for all.
