THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE

We are all very much looking forward to the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations this month. The Parish Council have been working closely with HoVEC to make sure all the events planned run smoothly and the village green is looking its best. We are certain that it will be a long weekend to remember!

To mark the Platinum Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II, the Parish Council have installed a commemorative bench. The new bench is located on the village green under the large Horse Chestnut tree and features a circular plaque within each armrest showing the official Platinum Jubilee logo. We hope that you agree it is a very special addition to the village.

SPEEDWATCH - CAN YOU HELP?

Speedwatch is a community-based scheme where volunteers record the speed of passing vehicles in the area where they live. Around 90% of vehicles observed once by Speedwatch volunteers are not seen speeding again in the next 12 months.

HORMONDEN PUBLIC TOILETS

Unfortunately, the difficult decision has been made by the Parish Council to lock the Public Toilets from 3pm each day due to a spate of continuous vandalism and unsociable behaviour. This is a temporary measure to see if things improve and the Council will continue to monitor and reassess the situation at regular intervals.

WORKS AT THE INSTITUTE BUILDING (SOCIAL CLUB)

Work will soon begin to install the William Lambert Plaque at the front of the Institute building in the disused doorway to the left of the main entrance. The plaque dates back to 1893 and is an intricate piece of commemorative stone work which was rescued from the former Boddington's factory site, located where Oliver's Court is now. William Lambert was an important character in Horsmonden history, owning a large engineering site located where Lamberts Place is currently, where he made and kept many steam engines. The plaque has been in storage for some years whilst the Council searched for a suitable place to display it.

We are looking forward to seeing the plaque in its new position soon for everyone to admire.

The building is also having smart new windows installed and work on this will have already started by the time you read this article!
