### **BASSETTS FARM APPLICATION 24/00078/HYBRID**

The Parish Council have been working closely with the Bassetts Farm Forum (BFF) with regards to this application and are currently preparing their 3-minute speech ready for when the application scheduled to be considered by the TWBC Planning Committee. At this stage, we do not know when this will happen but the earliest possible dates are 19 June or 24 July. Please keep an eye on our website and Facebook pages for updates regarding this.

### PARISH COUNCIL AUDIT AND ACCOUNTS

The Parish Council has now completed its Annual Governance and Accountability Return together with internal auditing for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024 and has sent all the relevant information off to the external auditors, Mazaars LLP who are responsible for completing the external audit.

Details of the accounts will be posted on the Parish Council's website under 'Finances and Audit' and will be available for public viewing by appointment from 3rd June to 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

#### **BEE FRIENDLY AT FROMANDEZ DRIVE**

Last year, the Parish Council made the decision to put their 'Planting for Nature' scheme into action.
Following advice from KCC, the site at Fromandez Drive was deemed the most suitable for wild flower planting. In May 2023, three small areas were temporarily fenced and planted with wild flower seeds including Yellow Rattle and the grass was left to grow and go to

seed. It was then cut once the seeds had fallen and removed at the beginning of September.

There are a wonderful group of volunteers who have just met recently to carry out some weeding and general tidying up of the area and as you can see from the photos, they are doing a great job!

## CPR AND DEFIBRILLATOR FAMILIARISATION TRAINING – 25<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2024

There are still some spaces available for CPR & Defibrillator Training on the 25<sup>th</sup> June. This is FREE training hosted by the Wealden Community First Responders.

Did you know that more than 30,000 people suffer cardiac arrests outside of hospital in the UK every year? If this happens in front of a bystander, who starts CPR immediately, the patient's chances of survival double.

#### **WORKS AT THE CLOCK TOWER**

The works at the Clock Tower are ongoing and unfortunately, are taking longer than we had hoped. The Parish Council are now in the process of applying for a grant from the TWBC West Kent Rural Grant Scheme which, if successful, could fund up to 50% of the cost of a new pitched roof. Unfortunately, this process has caused a delay as we now have to wait for a decision from TWBC but we hope that during the summer the anticipated works to the Clock Tower will be complete.
