SPEEDWATCH - CAN YOU HELP?

Speedwatch is a community-based scheme where volunteers record the speed of passing vehicles in the area where they live. Around 90% of vehicles observed once by Speedwatch volunteers are not seen speeding again in the next 12 months.

The village and surrounding areas are experiencing a lot of disruption due to Kent County Council roadworks. WORKS AT THE INSTITUTE BUILDING (SOCIAL CLUB)

The Parish Council have commissioned new windows and replacement doors at the side and rear entrances of the building and these will be fitted once more settled weather is with us.

Work has also now been commissioned to install the William Lambert Plaque at the front of the building in the disused doorway to the left of the main entrance. The plaque (1893) is an intricate piece of commemorative stone work which was rescued from the former Boddington's factory site, located where Oliver's Court is now. William Lambert was an important character in Horsmonden history, owning a large engineering site located where Lamberts Place is currently, where he made and kept many steam engines. The plaque has been in storage for some years whilst the Council searched for a suitable place to display it. It is hoped that this work will commence in mid-June.
