WORKS AT THE CLOCK TOWER

The Parish Council are delighted to confirm that the works at the Clock Tower are now complete and the scaffolding has finally been removed.

Various projects have been completed over the last 6 months including the replacement of two roofs, the repair and repaint of the timber structure, refurbishment and cleaning of the clock and rerepointing to the internal and external structure. The Parish Council would like thank parishioners for their support and patience whilst these essential works have been carried out.



PARKING AT THE VILLAGE HALL

The Village Hall car park is a private car park for use by hirers of the hall only. Unfortunately, there are often vehicles that are parked for long periods of time in the car park that are not involved with any groups hiring the hall and are therefore taking up valuable spaces. As owners of the car park, the Parish Council are regularly monitoring this and may be forced to take further action if the problem continues.

HORSMONDEN PUBLIC TOILETS

Unfortunately, over the summer months we have been experiencing further acts of vandalism at the public toilets. Our cleaning contractor has made a great effort to improve the overall appearance and cleanliness of the toilets so it is very disappointing that we are still experiencing these problems on a regular basis.
